

Website Terms of Use

Welcome to the Dyson Foundation (the “Foundation” or “Our” or “We”) Website. The Foundation’s website (the “Website”) provides information about our organization, our finances, our grantmaking policies and procedures, and instructions for submitting and monitoring grant applications. Our Website also contains a list of third-party resources that nonprofits might find useful. Please read these Terms of Use carefully before using our Website.

Acceptance of Terms: By accessing or using the Website, you agree to be bound by these Terms of Use and all applicable laws and regulations. If you object to any part of these Terms of Use, you must immediately discontinue use of the Website.

Changes to Terms: We reserve the right to modify or revise these Terms of Use at any time without notice. Any changes will be effective immediately upon posting. Your continued use of the Website following the posting of any changes constitutes your acceptance of those changes.

Eligible Users: This Website is offered and available to users who are 13 years of age or older. By using the Website, you represent and warrant that you have the right, authority, and capacity to consent to this policy. If you do not meet all of these requirements, you must not access or use the Website.
